

## **CURRENT REACH**



Our network of more than 900 food banks in over 40 countries distributes food to more than 16.9M people facing hunger (pre COVID-19) through over 56,000 social service organizations providing life changing services and help on the path to self-sufficiency.

In March – June 2020, GFN food banks expanded their reach, serving more than 22M people.






## **HEALTHY NATIONS START WITH HEALTHY CHILDREN**

In 2019, food banks in the GFN network served **6.2 million children** in partnership with thousands of community-based agencies and schools.

# FOOD BANK PROGRAMS & OPPORTUNITIES FOR PARTNERSHIP

## **Types of programs:**

- School breakfast programs: 23 food banks in 13 countries
- School lunch programs: 8 food banks in 6 countries
- Backpack programs: 4 food banks in 3 countries
- **Summer/ holiday food programs:** 9 food banks in 5 countries
- Food and nutrition education: 12 food banks in 7 countries

While food banks are well positioned to address child hunger and would like to continue or expand their programs, 74% of food banks report funding as a barrier and 54% report specific food procurement as an obstacle.
