- ✓ 44 countries served










Access to safe drinking water



The water that the family consumes is not potable and/or the family has to haul it from unfamiliar land, river or stream.



The family has access to potable water, but:
(a) is not constant or
(b) does not have a tap, well or cistern within the premises of the home.



The family has constant access-during most of the day-to potable water within the premises of their home.
They have a tap.


Our strengths







Poverty Stoplight Olympic Games



Geo-referencing: *Income above the poverty line*










Combining Indexes & Dashboards

Multidimensional Poverty Index MPI




Aggregated data from Dashboards
